Summary – New for this release:

- NCIN Changeover to Public Health England:** The CCT is a product of the National Cancer Intelligence Network (NCIN), from 1st April 2013 NCIN will be hosted by Public Health England (PHE). NHS users moving to PHE who require access will need to register with new organisation/email details.
- Public Access:** To comply with the Governments Transparency policy on Open Data, the CCT team have now produced a Public view. Please see the attached document 'Public View/NHS Access' for further information.
- New 'Log in' Path:** CCT users will now automatically be taken to the new Public view homepage of the CCT rather than the old log in screen. To log in registered users and new NHS users will need to select the 'Log in/Register' button in the top right of the CCT menu. Please see attached document 'Public View/NHS Access' for further information.
- General Practice Profiles:** Now viewable as a web page format within the CCT. Viewable by CCG's.
- Breast and Colorectal Service Profiles 2012 (including Data Definition Documents):** The service profiles have been updated and are available to NHS users.
- Alexa Toolkit:** Newly added application/tool to calculate the optimum caseload of a specialist nurse against best practice. It is based on a model of the work of a Lung Clinical Nurse Specialist. It uses previously modelled activity, national data and expert guidance to calculate a recommended caseload. It uses best practice guidance as a framework to determine the level of service that should be offered. The activity data has been tested and ratified by an expert reference group from the National Lung Cancer Forum for Nurses.
- Chemotherapy Nursing Workforce (CNS Census):** These PDF Network reports provide a brief analysis of the distribution of the Chemotherapy nurse workforce by hospital trust. This data was provided by the Cancer Networks in the 2012 census collection.
- Radiotherapy –** this is a spreadsheet by Radiotherapy centre showing incidents reported by organisations using the TSRT9 trigger code. A chart version will follow shortly.
- FAQ and Glossary:** Newly added documents to assist users with the use and understanding of the CCT.
- Updated Help Guides:** Arms & Principles, Core Functions, etc. help guides have been added. Please see 'Help' section.
