




Direct Flights from major cities

Airlines operating from Liverpool and Manchester Airports









































































Travelling by Rail

- Liverpool Lime Street Station is the city's mainline railway station located in the heart of Liverpool City centre
- O Liverpool has a high speed rail link from London with a journey time of just over 2 hours
- O Virgin Trains can offer a discounted rate for delegates travelling from London
- Liverpool has direct services to all major UK city's, (see table below for travel times), Scotland, North Wales and the Lake District
- Britrail pass available for international delegates to purchase
- O Easy transfer to mainland Europe via Eurostar

Local Travel

- Liverpool is a walkable city all major hotels, venues and attractions are within a 20 minute walk
- Circular shuttle buses connect the waterfront and city centre, running every 12-15 minutes, at a cost of around £2/€3
- Black Cab Taxis are all licensed and metered, with taxi ranks throughout city

Merseyrail provide a comprehensive underground system across Liverpool. Below is a list of city centre stations serving ACC Liverpool.

Liverpool Lime Street Station (Main Line, City Line and Wirral Line)

- 20 minute walk to ACC Liverpool
- 5-10 minute taxi ride to ACC Liverpool
- Wirral Line train to James Street

James Street Station (Wirral Line)

- 10-15 minute walk to ACC Liverpool
- 2-5 minute taxi ride

Central Station (Northern Line and Wirral Line)

- 20 minute walk
- 5 minute taxi ride

Moorfields Station (Northern Line and Wirral Line)

- 20 minute walk
- 5 minute taxi ride
