UROLOGY LMDT

- Essential part of cancer management
- Collaboration is central to coordinating the best treatment plan
- Individualised plans for each patient
- Referral to the Specialist MDT if necessary
- National Prostate Cancer Audit
- Holistic Needs Assessments

- Histo-pathologist
- MDT chair
- Cancer Nurse Specialists (CNS's)
- MDT coordinator
- Trials nurse
- Extended team

ATTENDANCE

- Signed register kept
- Core and extended members
- Quorate agreed locally
- The Chair is responsible for coordinating the meeting

TEAM WORKING

- Agreeing acceptable behaviours
- Mutual respect
- Equal voice for all
- Ensure outcomes are agreed
- Switch mobiles off/silent!!!!

MEETING ORGANISATION

- Weekly meetings
- Cut off for referrals
- Regular time and place
- Suitable environment
- Necessary electronic equipment
- Organisation of cases
- Circulation of list prior to meeting
- Electronic database to record outcomes

POST MDT COORDINATION

- Communication of new cancers to GP within 24hrs (peer review)
- Arrangements for informing patients of decisions in a timely manner
- Manage referrals between different MDT's
- Tracking patients through system to ensure tests, appointments are carried out
- Pre-book scans and options clinic appointments
